Through the Annual French Film Festival in Richmond, Virginia, Virginia Commonwealth University, University of Richmond, the Cultural Services of the French Embassy, and the American Association of Teachers of French of Virginia are again in collaboration providing middle and secondary-school teachers of French across the state, with the opportunity to use French and to increase their understanding of French culture through an immersion weekend associated with the activities of the **2019 French Film Festival** to be held on **March 28- 31, 2019.**

The French Film Festival in Richmond is a unique French cultural event founded and directed by Drs. Peter and Françoise Kirkpatrick. The festival showcases newly released films from France. All screenings are at the historic Byrd Theatre in Richmond and have English subtitles. The French actors and directors come to town to present their new films to the American public in the Byrd Theater with question/answer sessions after each screening. Eight Master classes open the Festival on Thursday and Friday at the Institute for Contemporary Art (ICA) at VCU. On Saturday evening, the French delegation of stars interacts further with viewers during the Official Reception also held at the ICA. In addition to the regular activities and events of the Festival, the immersion weekend is a wonderful experience for middle and high school teachers of French. VCU and UR's College of Humanities and Sciences, School of World Studies, Office of Community Programs, the Cultural Services of the French Embassy and the AATF of Virginia will offer an immersion French cultural weekend associated with the festival. Teachers will be able to **earn up to 2 or 3 graduate credits**.
